## An Introduction to 'The Three I's'

## Aims:

'The Three I's' refers to 'intent', 'implementation' and 'impact' which are integral for meeting the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage (2021). The aim of this session is to support practitioners to develop a greater understanding of how to deliver 'the three I's' in order to support children's development.

- Considered the importance of having clear learning intents for all children based on a current knowledge of their individual stages of development
- Considered what 'implementation' means in terms of the broad provision of learning environments, activities, resources, diverse pedagogical practices and effective teaching strategies
- A developed understanding of the importance of evaluating the impact of the work they have carried out with children in their early years
- Considered effective pedagogy in relation to their practices and how such practices support positive outcomes for all children.
